Extension of approval to Oriental College of Management Thakral Nagar, Opp. Patel Nagar, Raisen Road, Bhopal-462 021 Madhya Pradesh , for the year 2005-06-reg. Sir/Madam,

As you are aware, All India Council for Technical Education has been mandated under the AICTE Act, 1987 to ensure maintenance of norms and standards with regard to technical education in the country. In exercise of this mandate, the Council insists on fulfillment of the minimum requirements prescribed for imparting technical education by the institution so that quality of courses is not compromised and stakeholders are satisfied. The Council also undertakes an annual Inspection of the institutions and conveys deficiencies to them for rectification.

Such institutions suffer from critical deficiencies of faculty in proper cadre ratio's qualification, experience and other requirements. Feed back of students with regard to quality of education imparted by such institutions has evoked grave concern. The Expert Committees, following holistic appraisal during inspections, have also pointed out severe shortcomings in key areas.

The institution was allowed to be established in the year 2004-05. The Inspection and Appraisal have revealed that adequate steps to provide the requisite infrastructure necessary for imparting quality technical education have not been taken. The institution has been found to be suffering from several deficiencies which are listed in Annexure-A for your perusal of which faculty shortage is the most critical.

The deficiencies particularly faculty shortage have evoked grave concern and rendered the institution liable for strict punitive action including being placed in no admission/reduced intake category. However the Council has decided that yet another last opportunity may be given to the institution to improve the situation as you are still a fledgling institution.

It has thus been decided to extend approval in respect of the institution for the year 2005-06 as Indicated below, subject to rectification of deficiencies by end of August, 2005. The Council shall monitor progress in this regard carefully and strictly and shall put your institution in no admission/reduced intake category for the year 2006-07 without any further opportunity in the event of your failure to comply with the aforementioned stipulations. A compliance report in respect of deficiencies listed in **Annexure-A** must be sent to the Council **with a copy to the concerned Regional office** before 31st August, 2005 in the absence whereof extension of approval for year 2006-07 may not be considered.

The Compliance Report to be submitted to the Council by 31st August, 2005 should also be accompanied with a **visiting/processing fee** as prescribed by the Council in the form of demand draft in favour of the Member Secretary, AICTE payable at New Delhi. In the absence of the processing/visiting fee, the compliance report may not be entertained.

Faculty:

- Faculty is the soul of an institution and in the absence thereof an institution cannot impart quality education. However the faculty available with the institution is 3 (25%)
- Principal as per AICTE norms of qualifications as well as experience to be appointed.

Library facility:

- Against the requirement of 2100 books, only 521 books are available thereby causing a shortfall of 1579 (75.19%). additional textbooks/reference books to be purchased.
- Against the requirement of 30 journals, only 5 journals are available thereby causing a shortfall of 25 (83.33%).

Computer facility:

- No LAN facility available, against the requirement of 15 computers, thereby causing as shortfall of 15 (100%)
- At preesnt Computer facility is shared with engg. Instt. hence, exclusive Computer Lab to be provided.
 - Internet connectivity to be provided.

Others:

- Academic ambience of the MBA institute is quite poor Class room, Library, Laboratory, Faculty room, Directors room, Students room Seminar room, lecture rooms, tutorial rooms needed for MBA program are still under construction which should be completed by July 2005
- Facilities are shared with engg. College.
- Common room for girls & boys and staff room are inadequate and inappopriate.
- LCD required for class rooms. The infracture for MBA is inadequate and requires improvement, , furnishing of class room, lab faculty room requires upgradation.
