May, 2008, failing whick action would be initiated as per the rules and regulations of the AICTE including No Admission / Withdrawal of approval.

The institution is required to submittwo copies of the Compliance Report, indicating the rectification of deficiences along with mandatory disclosure and deals of faculty recruited for each course in the prescribed format (available at 1801). Website www.aicte.ernet.in) to be concerned Regional Office latest by 31 August 2008 for consideration of approval beyond the session 2008-09. It may be noted that all the institutions are required to submit the Compliance Report along with requisite processing fee by 31 August, every year, irrespective of the period of approval.

The Compliance Report must be accompanied with a processing fee of Rs. 40,000/- in the form of demand draft in the favour of Member Secretary, AICTE payable at New Delhi. In the absence of processing fee the Compliance Report will not be entertained. Following the Compliance report, the Council would verify the status in respect of rectification of deficiences through surprise random inspection athout any prior notice.

The above approval if granted afterectification of deficiencies would be subject to the fulfillment of ine following general conditions:

- That the management stall provide adequate funds for development of land and for providing related infrastructural, instructional and other facilities as per norms and standards laid down by the Council from time to time and for meeting recurring expenditure.
- (a) That the admissionshall be made only after adequate infrastructure and all other facilities are provided as per noms and guidelines of the AICTE.
 - (b) That the admission shall be made in accordance with the regulations notified by the Council from time to time.
 - (c) That the curriculumof the course, the procedure for evaluation/ assessment of students shall be in accordance with the norms prescribed by the AICTE.
 - (d) That the Institutionshall not allow closure of the Institution or discontinuation of the course(s) and any new course(s) a alter intake capacity of seats without the prior approval of the Course.
 - (e) That no excess admission shall be made by the Institution over and above the approved incide under any circumstances. In case any excess admission is reported to the Council, appropriate penal action including withdrawal of approval shall be initiated against the Institution
 - (f) That the institution shall not have any collaborative arrangements with any Indian and/ or Foreign
 Universities for conduct of technical courses other than those approved by AICTE without obtaining once
 approval from AICTE. In case any violation is reported to the Council, appropriate penal action including
 withdrawal of approval shall be initiated against the Institution.
 - (g) That the Institutionshall not conduct any course(s) in the field of technical education in the same premises/ campus ad / or in the name of the Institution without prior permission/ approval of AICTE. In case any violation is reported to the Council, appropriate penal action including withdrawal of approval shall be initiated against the Institution.
 - (h) The institution shallest conduct any non-technical course(s) in the same premises/ campus under any circumstances. In case any violation is reported to the Council, appropriate penal action including withdra wall of approach shall be initiated against the Institution

OHO:

- That the tuition and offer fees shall be charged as prescribed by the Competent Authority within the overall criteria prescribed by the Council from time to time. No capitation fee shall be charged from the students of students in any form.
- That the accounts of the Institution shall be audited annually by a certified Charured Accountant and shall be open for inspection by the Council or any body or persons authorized by it.
- That the Director/ Primpal and the teaching and other staff shall be selected according to procedures, qualifications and experience prescribed by the Council from time to time and pay scales are as periods, needs prescribed by the Council from time to time.
- 7 (a) That the institution shall furnish requisite returns and reports as desired by CAICTE in order to ensure proper maintenance of administrative and academic standards.
 - (b) That the technical institution shall publish an information booklet before commencement of the academic year giving detas regarding the institution and courses/ programmes being conducted and details of infrastructural facilities including faculty etc. in the form of mandatory disclosure. The information booklet may be made available to the stakeholders of the technical education on cost leasts. The mandatory disclosure information shall be put on the Institution. The information shall be revised every year with updated information about all aspects of the institution.
 - (c) That it shall be sandatory for the technical institution to maintain a Website providing the prescribed information. The Website information must be continuously updated as and when changes take place.
 - (d) That a compliane report in the prescribed format along with mandatory disclosures on Auffiliment of the above conditions, shall be submitted each year by the Institution within the time limit prescribed by the Council from timeto time i.e. 31st August 2008 for the current year.
 - (e) That if Technica Institution fails to disclose the information or suppress and/ or misremesent the information, appapriate action could be initiated including withdrawal of ALCTE approval.
- 8 That all the laboratories, workshops etc. shall be equipped as per the syllabil of the concerned affiliated university and shall be in operational and the laboratorial and the concerned affiliated university.
- That a library shall be estallished with adequate number of tides, books, journals (both Indian & Foreign) are at per AICTE norms.
- 10 That a computer center will adequate number of terminals, Printers etc. shall be established as per APLT's norms.
- AICTE may carry out random inspections round the year for verifying the status of the Institutions to ensure maintenance of norms and tandards
- 12 nat the AICTE may also unduct inspections with or without notifying the dates to verify specific complaints of mis-representation, violational norms and standards, mai-practices etc.
- 13 that the Institution by virtue of the approval given by Council shall not automatically become claiment to any grantin-aid form the Central or Sate Government.
- 14 That in the event of a spident / candidate withdrawing before the starting of the course, the wait listed candidates shouldbe given admission against the vacant seat. The entire fee collected from the student, after a deluction of the processing fee of not more than Rs. 1000/- (Repeas One thousand only) shall be refunded and returned by the Institution / University to the student/candidate withdawing from the programme. It would not be permissible for Institutions and Universities to retain the School/Institution Leaving Certificates in ordered to force retention of admitted students (See Riblic Notice AICTE/DPG/03(01)/2008).
