1. Objectives Of The MoU


8. Non-Exclusivity

10. Relationship

Nothing in this MOU shall be construed to make party a partner, an agent or legal representative of the other for any purpose.

11. Assignment

It is understood by the Parties herein this MOU is based on the professional competence and expertise of each party and hence neither Party shall transfer or assign this Agreement, or rights or obligations arising hereunder, either wholly or in part, to any third party.

12. Costs Of The Mou

Each Party shall bear the respective costs of carrying out the obligations under this MOU.

13. Other Terms And Conditions

- Neither party may use the other's corporate name or any trade mark or name or any other items or assets protected by intellectual property rights, including but not restricted to, use in any promotional material, press releases, advertisements, communications, stationery, web sites, or the like.
- The laws of the Republic of India shall govern this MoU.
- All communication between the parties shall be in writing and in English Language.

14. Approval Authority

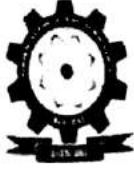



- a) Exchange of personnel through deputation as per the rules of the respective institute, for limited periods as mutually agreed upon;
- b) Organization of joint conferences and seminars;
- c) Practical training of OCT,Bhopal students at Dreamsoft Systems ;
- d) Joint guidance of student projects/thesis in Information Technology and other areas of institute interest at OCT,Bhopal by Dreamsoft Systems on mutually agreeable terms.

- k) DREAMSOFT SYSTEMS may avail library, Internet, computational facilities at OCT,BHOPAL.
- l) Post-graduate student will be allotted a Research supervisor from OCT,BHOPAL faculty members. A Research Engineer at DREAMSOFT SYSTEMS may be appointed asa Co- research guide as per the rules of the respective institute for a student registered for M.Tech (Regular or Research) degree at OCT,BHOPAL. The student maybe encouraged to take up the project such that DREAMSOFT SYSTEMS desirably benefits from its outcomes.
- m) The students will carry out part of their M.Tech./B.Tech. project at OCT,BHOPAL and DREAMSOFT SYSTEMS depending on the nature of the work as per rules of the respective institutes depending on facilities and requirements.



Hereafter referred to as INSTITUTE, of the Second part, for the purpose of exchange of faculty and Students

The aforesaid institutions are hereafter referred to individually as Institute and collectively as institutes.

Preamble

Whereas, Institute covering the big spectrum of academics to enhance proportion of skilled based courses beyond curriculum to create more employable graduates and to undertake interdisciplinary research and development by engaging the faculty and students in curricular, co-curricular and industry collaborated projects towards problem solving

Whereas, Headstart Network Foundation is a not-for-profit organization started by few passionate individuals with an effort to bring successful startup founders together, to share their stories with fellow first time entrepreneurs.

To facilitate the Academic Industry linkage, Headstart Network Foundation and Institute have decided to enter into this Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter referred to as MoU),

11. Institute will provide venue and logistics support for Headstart initiatives across the city.
12. Institute will setup a team of 10 individuals for Headstart and E-Cell activities

13. Headstart Network Foundation will support the activities of E-Cell to spread knowledge of entrepreneurship among students, and various other activities through support of E-Cell

Both institutes will promote and work collaboratively in developing conducive atmosphere towards Startups and Entrepreneurial culture in the city and the Institute.

14. To support the institutes entrepreneurial In following activities.

- A. **Campus Connect:** Student specific initiative for building startup learning and methodologies, involving exposure from various proven entrepreneurs in a simple dialog exchange where students can easily ask their doubts and get answers around starting up.
- B. **Mentor:** A mentoring session to cater problems around a specific subject with a subject matter expert usually involving 5 mentees.
- C. **Higher:** A hiring platform where 'Selected Startups' meet selected 'Startup Ready' job-seekers in a speed dating format. It's not a job fair and is by invitation only. One has to apply and go through a selection process before they can make it to the hiring day.
- D. **Kickstart:** A event where fundable startups pitch to investors. After inviting applications, the startups are shortlisted after careful scrutiny. Qualifying startups battle it out in a fiery pitch session in front of a jury. Note: This is a closed door session and only shortlisted startups may pitch.
- E. **Partner Events:** Headstarts' national level visibility and reach gets numerous opportunities to maximize impact to every city. Headstart partners with esteemed organizations and initiatives which they feel will add up in their efforts of helping people in starting up better. By this association with institute-incubator, both will contribute to the nation's need of creating and developing startups', entrepreneurial ecosystem in the central India and in campus too.

As both the institutions have their various roles in different sectors, they will also work collaboratively and support each other in various activities mentioned above. For any research work, separate agreements of deliverables and IPR generation would be drafted and signed.

ARTICLE 2: COORDINATION


Each institution shall appoint one member of its teaching/research faculty to coordinate the programme on its behalf. Further, a coordination committee consisting of a programme coordinator from the side of Headstart Network Foundation, and a programme coordinator from the side of Institute, will periodically review and identify ways to strengthen cooperation between the two institutions.

- a) Exchange of personnel through deputation as per the rules of the respective institute, for limited periods as mutually agreed upon;
- b) Organization of joint conferences and seminars;
- c) Practical training of OCT,Bhopal students at Dreamsoft Systems ;
