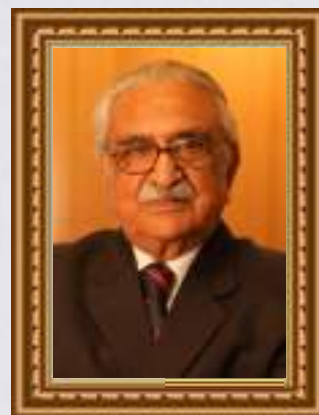

The days of grief and mourning at the Oriental Group kept the campus in a somber state, for some days and months together.

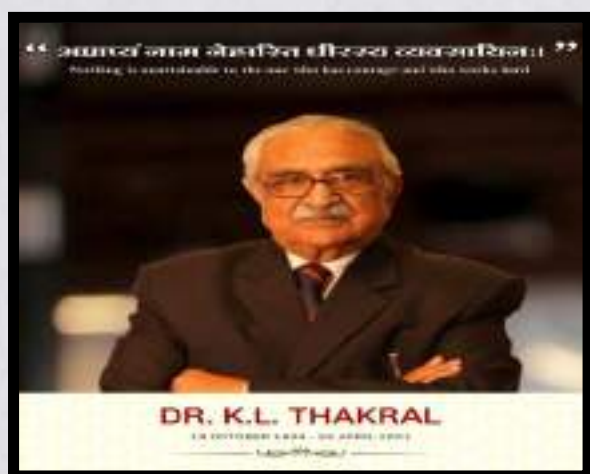
Wheels of time rolled on, an year passed by, after the founder's death anniversary. Healing took place and the aura of the departed soul rested a while, to bless us all.

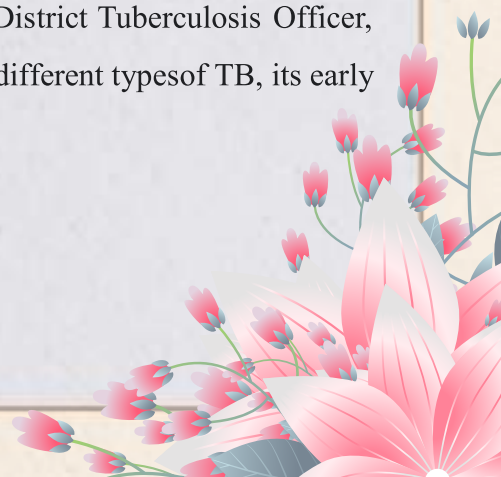
International Women's Day celebration

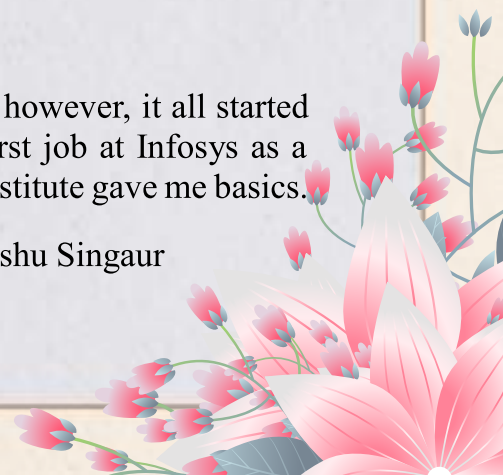

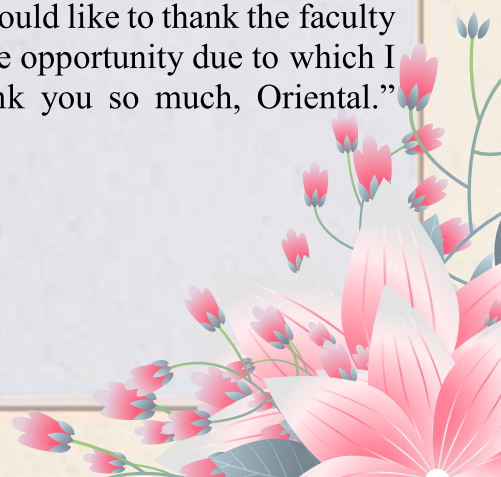
